Important Notes for Diving (Fun Diving, Introductory Diving and Diving License Course)

- ▶ Individuals with heart conditions, epilepsy, or who are pregnant are precluded from diving. Additionally, those currently ill, under treatment, taking medication, or with **conditions listed below** may be denied participation or asked to provide a doctor's note. Please consult with us in advance if any of the above applies. Individuals who appear unwell, hungover, or have consumed alcohol on the day will also be denied participation.
Asthma, Tuberculosis, Pneumonia, Pneumothorax, Severe rhinitis, Severe hay fever, Other respiratory issues, Otitis media (middle ear infection), Otitis externa (outer ear infection), Heart conditions, Arrhythmia or palpitations, High blood pressure, Angina, Other circulatory system issues, Diabetes, Epilepsy, Propensity for dizziness or unconsciousness, Claustrophobia, Perforated eardrum, Other ear-related issues, Pregnancy, Currently taking medication, Currently under medical treatment
- ▶ Please note that you cannot board a flight immediately after diving due to the risk of decompression sickness. If you have completed multiple dives over several days, wait at least 18 hours before flying. After a single dive, a minimum wait of 12 hours is required before flying.

The Refresh Course is designed for those who feel anxious about diving. An instructor will closely support you during your first dive, offering advice on everything from setting up equipment, using the equipment, entry/exit methods, equalizing techniques, mask clearing, regulator clearing/recovery, and underwater posture. A relaxed pace ensures you can confidently join fun diving for subsequent dives.

Participation Requirements

Participants must be healthy and hold a diving license. You should not have a flight scheduled on the day of diving. Minors require parental consent.

Diving license card, logbook, swimsuit, towel, change of clothes, sandals, seasickness medicine (if needed), and sunscreen.

Participation Requirements	Participants must be at least 10 years old and in good physical and mental health. You should not have a flight scheduled on the day of diving. Minors require parental consent.
What to Bring	Swimsuit, towel, change of clothes, sandals, seasickness medicine (if needed), and sunscreen.
Note	If you have small children, babysitting services can be introduced. There may be times when the introductory diving course cannot be conducted due to peak season or sea conditions.

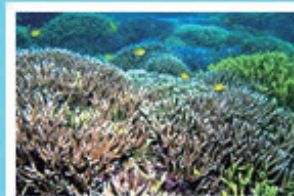
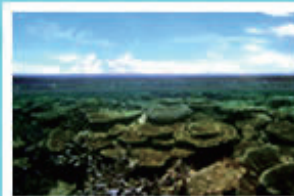

Participation Requirements	Participants must be healthy and in good physical condition. Minors require parental consent.
What to Bring	Swimsuit, towel, change of clothes, sandals, seasickness medicine (if needed), and sunscreen.
Note	As you will be spending time on the boat when not snorkeling, those prone to seasickness should take medication before departure (choose non-drowsy options). If needed, bring a boat coat (similar to a windbreaker).

Diving beginner's licenses are available to anyone healthy and aged 10 and up (those under 14 will receive a junior certification). Diving is a sport that you can enjoy for a long time. Why not take up this wonderful hobby that lets you play in the beautiful underwater world? After a 3-day course, you can dive in seas all over the world. We also offer skill-up courses from time to time. Please feel free to contact us.

Open Water Diver Course - 3 Days

※All prices include tax. Additional: fuel surcharge.

Individual participant: 88,000 JPY

Group participation (2 or more): 71,500 JPY per person

Participation Requirements	Anyone healthy and aged 10 years or older can participate (those under 14 will receive junior certification). Minors require parental consent. Please note, you cannot fly on the same day as diving due to decompression sickness precautions.
Price Includes	Instruction fee, tank, weights, boat fee, complete diving equipment, lunch, soft drinks, course materials, application fee for the certification card, insurance, and transportation to and from accommodations within the city.
Items to Prepare	Swimsuit, towel, beach sandals, two passport-style color photos (4cm x 3cm), writing materials (for classroom use), delivered course materials (manual), seasickness medication (if needed), and appropriate clothing for the weather, such as a boat coat or sun protection.
Note	The certification card will be delivered to your home approximately three weeks after application (you can dive with a temporary card in the meantime).

Participation Requirements	Must be a PADI Open Water Diver or equivalent, 12 years or older, with proof of at least 4 dives if certified by another organization
Price Includes	Instruction fee, tank, weights, boat fee, lunch, soft drinks, course materials, application fee for the certification card, insurance, and transportation to and from accommodations within the city.
Items to Prepare	Swimsuit, towel, beach sandals, two passport-style color photos (4 cm x 3 cm), writing materials (for use during classroom sessions), delivered materials (manual), certification card & logbook, training record (if you are a PADI diver), motion sickness medication (if concerned about seasickness), boat coat or other cold-weather gear, sun protection clothing (depending on the season and conditions).
Note	Deep and Navigation are two mandatory subjects. You will also choose three additional elective subjects, making a total of five dives.

Important Notes

If you cannot complete the course within two days due to ill health, insufficient preparatory study, or lack of practical skills, and remedial lessons are needed, additional fees will be charged according to the extent and time required. Normally, if you come in good health, have properly prepared in advance, and participate earnestly in the course, remedial lessons will not be necessary, so please be reassured. Considering the possibility of sudden bad weather or ill health, we recommend that you allow some flexibility in your schedule. Please note that during peak seasons, some courses might not be conducted depending on the schedule.

Additionally, we regularly offer step-up courses such as the EFR Course, Rescue Diver Course, Dive Master Course, and Specialty Courses. Feel free to contact us for more information.

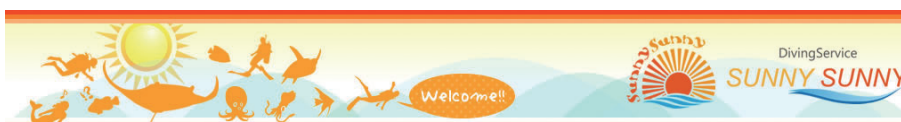
